Preamble

Whereas it appears by message from Her Excellency the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean, Governor General of Canada, and the Estimates accompanying that message, that the sums mentioned below are required to defray certain expenses of the federal public administration, not otherwise provided for, for the financial year ending March 31, 2007, and for other purposes connected with the federal public administration;
